Pursuant to Section 4 of the Natural Gas Act (“NGA”) and Part 154 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“FERC” or “Commission”) regulations,<sup>1</sup> Gas Transmission Northwest Corporation (“GTN”) hereby submits for filing a proposed substitute Table of Contents, v.1.1.0 (“Section 1, v.1.1.0”),<sup>2</sup> included at Appendix A, to be part of its FERC Gas Tariff, Fourth Revised Volume No. 1-A (“Electronic Tariff”). GTN is submitting Section 1, v.1.1.0, to update the Table of Contents in its Electronic Tariff to reflect the addition of Section 4.10. GTN respectfully requests that the Commission accept Section 1, v.1.1.0, to be effective August 9, 2010.

### **Statement of the Nature, Reasons, and Basis for Filing**

On June 30, 2010, in Docket No. RP10-911-000, GTN submitted its baseline Electronic Tariff,<sup>3</sup> which superseded its sheet-based tariff<sup>4</sup> effective June 30, 2010. At the time GTN filed its baseline Electronic Tariff, previously-filed Original Sheet Nos. 29C and 29D (“Sheets 29C and 29D”) were pending Commission approval<sup>5</sup> and were therefore not included in GTN’s baseline electronic tariff filing, consistent with the requirements of Order No. 714.<sup>6</sup>

On July 9, 2010, in Docket No. RP10-954-000, GTN submitted a tariff filing with the Commission in order to add a new section<sup>7</sup> to its Electronic Tariff along with a revised Table of Contents (“Section 1, v.1.0.0”). These tariff changes were subsequently approved by the Commission to become effective August 9, 2010.<sup>8</sup>

On July 29, 2010, the Commission accepted Sheets 29C and 29D to become effective August 1, 2010, subject to further review and order of the Commission.<sup>9</sup> As a result, GTN subsequently

filed to update its Electronic Tariff with these approved tariff changes.<sup>10</sup> In doing so, GTN inserted the contents of Sheets 29C and 29D as Section 4.10 and modified its baseline Table of Contents to reflect the addition of Section 4.10 to the Electronic Tariff.

In the instant filing, GTN is proposing to substitute the Table of Contents that was included in the July 9, 2010, tariff filing with a Table of Contents that references Section 4.10.<sup>11</sup> As such, substitute Section 1, v.1.1.0, included herein at Appendix A, includes a reference to Section 4.10. GTN respectfully requests that the Commission approve Section 1, v.1.1.0, to be effective August 9, 2010, which is the date the Commission accepted Section 1, v.1.0.0, in the July 9 filing.

### **Effective Date and Request for Waiver**

GTN respectfully requests that the Commission accept Section 1, v.1.1.0, to be effective August 9, 2010. GTN further requests that the Commission grant any waivers necessary to allow for these effective dates.

### **Other Filings Which May Affect This Proceeding**

On September 29, 2010, in Docket No. RP10-1368-000, GTN submitted, among other tariff provisions, squeeze tariff provision Part 1 – Table of Contents, v.0.0.1 (“Section 1, v.0.0.1”), which is currently pending before the Commission.

### **Contents of Filing**
